4.5% ABV – Light-bodied Belgian Witbier – Smooth with tastes of orange, coriander, slight cloves, & vanilla

**Bell's Expedition Stout – 11 oz. \$5.50** *Kalamazoo, Michigan*

10.5% ABV – Russian Imperial Stout, full bodied & nicely balanced – Moderate carbonation, notes of chocolate & coffee – smooth, creamy finish

5.8% ABV – Amber colored brew with light notes of citrus & malts – Light/medium body with medium carbonation

On Deck: *Pumpkin/Oktoberfest*

**Victory Lager – 16 oz. \$4.50** *Downingtown, Pennsylvania*

4.8% ABV – Golden colored Lager – Subtle aroma with a hint of citrus – Grassy flavor with a dry/hoppy finish – Medium body & carbonation

On Deck: *Victory Moonglow Weizenbock – 11 oz. \$5.00 Downingtown, Pennsylvania*

**Ithaca Flower Power IPA – 16 oz. \$5.50** *Ithaca, New York*

7.5% ABV – American East Coast India Pale Ale – Amber in color with citrus, & a strong floral nose – Medium to full body with a bitter & dry finish

### **Beck's Oktoberfest – 16 oz. \$4.50** *Bremen, Germany*

5.0% ABV – Cooper colored Märzen – Sweet scent with a touch of hops -  
Malty taste with a medium body & medium carbonation

### **Brew Works Devious Imperial Pumpkin – 11 oz. \$4.50** *Allentown, Pennsylvania*

9.0% ABV – Orange/amber color – Notes of cinnamon, nutmeg, & pumpkin –  
Medium body and well carbonated

### **Dogfish Head 60 Minute IPA – 16 oz. \$5.00** *Milton, Delaware*

6.0% ABV – Amber color – Scents of pine, grapefruit, hops – Pine taste up  
front, finish of bitterness & grapefruit – Medium body and mild carbonation

### **Palm – 12 oz. \$5.50** *Steenhuffel, Belgium*

5.4% ABV-The number one selling amber beer in Belgium. Toasty maltiness,  
orange notes and very clean finish, perfect for all beer drinkers

### **\*Piraat Ale – 11 oz. \$7.50** *Ertvelde, Belgium*

10.5% ABV – Considered a Belgian IPA – Orange in color, sweet & fruity nose – hint of  
citrus hops – taste of vanilla, cloves & banana – Medium body, crisp carbonation

### **Spaten Oktoberfestbier – 16 oz. \$5.00** *München, Germany*

5.9% ABV – Copper colored, medium body, mild carbonation & malty – Well  
balanced taste

### **Slyfox Oktoberfest – 16 oz. \$4.50** *Phoenixville, Pennsylvania*

5.8% ABV – Amber color Märzen – Malty scent with a hint of cinnamon &  
nutmeg – Medium body with moderate carbonation

### **Tröegs Java Head Stout – 11 oz. \$4.50** *Harrisburg, Pennsylvania*

7.5% ABV – Dark & deep color – Aroma of chocolate, vanilla, & malt – Bitter  
sweet chocolate taste with a smoked finish – Medium to full bodied

### **Victory Moonglow Weizenbock – 11 oz. \$5.00** *Downingtown, Pennsylvania*

8.7% ABV – Cloudy amber color – Scent of bread, fruit, & caramel – Fruit taste  
upfront, finishes slightly sweet – Medium body & well carbonated
